
Vivid Sydney at Taronga Zoo

now to get there	 Taronga Zoo Sydney is located on Bradleys Head Road in Mosman, right on Sydney Harbour and easily accessible from the Sydney CBD. For guests entering after 4.30pm, parking will be discounted to half price. For guests entering prior to 4pm, the parking is a flat rate of \$22 for the whole day, or free if entering and exiting within 90 minutes. Please note: there is no 90-minute grace period after 4pm. By public transport The Zoo is located 12 minutes from Circular Quay by ferry or a short bus trip from the city or North Sydney. Additional ferry services to Circular Quay and bus services to Spit Junction will be running from the zoo during Vivid. Please note: there will be no entry via the Zoo's lower entrance or Sky Safari cable car during Vivid.
